
Position Summary

Compensation & Benefits

The City of Safford offers a competitive salary depending on qualifications and experience. A generous benefits package is offered that includes health insurance, with an option of either an EPO or a high-deductible plan. The City pays 90% of the premiums for dental, vision, and health insurance. A work cell phone is provided, as well as paid vacation and sick leave. A retirement plan is provided through the Arizona State Retirement System (ASRS) with the current employee contribution and employer matching rate, at 12.27% of salary. Up to \$4,000 in relocation expenses is available with verifiable receipts.

The Community

The City of Safford is the county seat of Graham County and is located in the Upper Gila River Valley in the southeast corner of Arizona. Safford is a full-service city and consists of nearly 10,000 residents.

The Safford Unified School District serves the entire City of Safford and some minor outlying areas with three elementary schools including Dorothy Stinson, Ruth Powell, and Lafe Nelson, as well as one Safford Middle School and one Safford High School.



Safford is also home to the Eastern Arizona College's Discovery Park Campus, a unique public educational destination facility that provides tours of

the world-class telescopes at the Mt. Graham International Observatory (MGIO). It provides free public access to the observatory with a research grade 20" Cassegrain reflector telescope and dome for the Gov Aker Observatory, donated by the University of Arizona. This is the World's largest permanent mount "Camera Obscura", a full motion Shuttle simulator that takes you on an exciting ride through the Milky Way galaxy, and galleries of historical artifacts from Graham County and the "History of Astronomy" Gallery, as well as a beautifully



restored Sonoran riparian area featuring a one-acre ecology education pond and over four miles of trails that take you through the habitat of native a migratory birds, reptiles, and mammals.

The City of Safford's public safety is served by the Safford Police Department and Fire protection is provided by the Safford Volunteer Fire Department. The Fire Dept consists of a Fire Chief, Assistant Chief and 31 other volunteer firefighters, responding to more than 200 calls per year and servicing the city's 6.2 sq miles as well as encompassing an area of 110 sq miles outside the city.
