
WELCOME TO Upper Darby



HISTORY

The original inhabitants of what is now Pennsylvania included the Algonquin, Lenape, Delaware, Huron, Iroquois, and Susquehannock. The Nanticoke and Shawnee later migrated into Pennsylvania and New Jersey after the first Europeans arrived. In the early 1600s, there were an estimated 5,000-7,000 Susquehannock Native Americans living in the region, but by 1700, that number had dwindled to 300, likely due to diseases brought by Europeans. Although 2020 census reports a Native American population of more than 12,000, there are no federally recognized Native American tribes in Pennsylvania

The **Susquehanna River** or "Siskëwahane" (Muddy River) or "Sisa'we'hak'hanna" (Oyster River) included widespread oyster beads near the mouth of the river which the Lenape farmed.



Pennsylvania / Philadelphia

Although first colonized by the Dutch in 1643, the English took control of the area in 1667, and in 1681, Pennsylvania became an English colony when **William Penn**, a **Quaker** received a royal deed from **King Charles II** of England. Established a colony of religious tolerance, by the mid-1700s, the colony had attracted many German and Scotch-Irish immigrants.

Philadelphia was founded in 1682 by **William Penn** on the confluence of the Delaware and Schuylkill rivers.



Home to **Benjamin Franklin**, the world renowned scientist / inventor / publisher / diplomat, Philadelphia quickly grew into an important colonial city, becoming the site of the **First & Second Continental Congresses**, the signing of the **Declaration of Independence** in 1776, and the seat of the **American Revolution**.

Upper Darby

Founded in 1786, Upper Darby is the 6th largest municipality in Pennsylvania.

In 1974 Upper Darby became a 'home rule' township in **Delaware County.** Today, more than 85,000 residents (24% foreign-born) call Upper Darby home.

In 2020 the community voted on a motto for Upper Darby, "The World in One Place" reflecting the multicultural community of the present day.





GEOGRAPHY

Upper Darby is located along the Eastern Seaboard, in the Delaware (River) Valley, in the state of Pennsylvania, at the confluence of the Delaware and Schuylkill rivers within the Philadelphia Metro Area - 6th most populated city in the United States.


International Airports

- ♦ Philidelphia International Airport (PHX) is the primary airport serving the Philadelphia Metro Area with over 12,400,000 passengers annually, it is the 21st busiest airport in the US. It is serviced by 22 US & International carriers including: Air Lingus, Air Canada, Alaska, American, American Eagle, British Airways, Contour, Discover, Delta, Frontier, JetBlue, Southwest, Spirit, Sun Country & United. Direct access to 140 US and international markets.

CLIMATE

Philadelphia / Upper Darby is in a humid continental climate zone. This means we experience four distinct seasons, including hot summers and cold winters. Historically, winters have an average temperature of 41.9°F, and summers have an average temperature of 84.5°F.

The area receives an average of 47 inches of rain per year (the US average is 38"), averages 13 inches of snow per year (US average is 28"), and averages 207 sunny days per year (US average is 205) and gets some precipitation, on average, 119 days per year.





COMMERCE

PHILADELPHIA. By the 1770's Philadelphia had a population of 30,000 and was the third most important business center in the British Empire, exceeded only by London and Liverpool. Philadelphia surpassed New York in commerce until about 1819 and in finance until about 1850. Philadelphia was also a major center of the industrial revolution in America.

Today, the **Philadelphia-metro economy generates \$445 billion in GDP**. 23 of the nation's Fortune 500 companies are located in the Philadelphia-metro area.

Philadelphia's economic sectors include higher education, manufacturing, oil refining, food processing, health care and biotechnology, telecommunications, tourism and financial services.

DEMOGRAPHICS

Population: Most recent census data shows a resident population of 85,681 in 33,548 households. Largest segments of the local population are ages 30-36 (20%) and 20-29 (15%). The Median Age in Upper Darby is 34.6 years.

Heritage: 19% of residents are foreign-born, and 99% are citizens of the USA.

Ethnicity: Upper Darby's ethnicity is composed of 42% White, 9% Hispanic or Latino, 34% Black or African American, and 12% Asian.

Median Household Income: Based on 2020 data, Upper Darby residents have a median household income of \$62,200. 16% are below the poverty line.

Education Achievement: 12% Graduate, 20% Bachelor, 30% High School, 30% some college, 9% no diploma.

Property Values: The median property value was \$181,600 (2020). 56% ownership.

ABOUT THE TOWNSHIP

Form of Government

Upper Darby has a **Home-rule** charter and utilizes a **Mayor-Council** *form of government* remaining relatively stable for 50 years.

The Mayor is elected *at-large* and serves as the Chief Executive. The Mayor is elected to a four-year term, limited to no more than three successive terms. The Mayor is a part-time position. **7 of 11 Township Council Members** are elected from each of the Town's 7 Districts, plus four (4) elected at-large.


Council Members serve four-year, staggered terms. Council Members in-turn elect a **President, Vice-President, and Secretary**.

Mayor and Council provide vision and policy direction for the Township, enact legislation, set policy, and adopt the annual budget.



The Mayor hires a **Chief Executive Officer (CAO)** to manage daily operations and implement the Mayor and Council's vision and policies.

Mayor and Council bios demonstrate a high-level of professionalism, diversity and years of public and private service to the community.



SENIOR MANAGEMENT TEAM

The Chief Administrative Officer (CAO)

The Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) is hired by the Mayor to implement policy and laws adopted by the Council, and manage operations directed by the Mayor. He / She is also responsible for the preparation of the annual & capital budgets, management of the Township's assets, procurement, personnel, and the effective / efficient organization of all City Departments under your authority.

Upper Darby is a 'full-service' local government. An experienced Senior Management Team leads over 400 employees in 10 departments, not including the Offices of the Mayor (1 FTE) & CAO (3 FTEs).

FINANCE DEPARTMENT

About the Finance Department

The **Finance Department** consists of 10 full-time employees who are responsible for *Accounting, Bookkeeping, Controller, Payroll, Operations and Tax Collection*.



The Director of Finance / CFO

The Director of Finance / CFO is responsible for planning and coordinating all Municipal financial transactions and purchases, financial forecasting and planning, budgeting, reporting, systems development, debt and cash management, internal auditing, investment / grants management, payroll, rev. collection, risk management, and pension administration.

The Director of Finance / CFO reports to the Township Administrator and is responsible for all areas of financial management for the Upper Darby Township, and is responsible for the management of:

- ♦ \$107m in annual revenues,
- \$459m in assets and liabilities, and
- \$89m General Fund Operating Budget.

The Chief Financial Officer (continued):

Essential duties & Responsibilities:

- Establishing and maintaining an accounting system designed to accurately reflect the assets, liabilities, receipts and expenditures of the Municipality.
- ♦ Collect and prepare financial data needed for the constructions of the annual budget; Prepare the annual budget under the supervision of CAO.
- Supervise and implement all aspects of payroll, accounts payable, accounts receivables, sewer rental, business privilege tax, mercantile tax, occupational privilege tax, amusement tax, pension, debt and cash management, banking, auditing, internal control, budgeting and financial reporting.
- ♦ Supervise, train and discipline Finance Department personnel.
- ⋄ Prepare and approve journal entries, warrant requests, subsidiary entries, and account analysis.
- Oversee all accounting and record-keeping systems; reviews general ledger accounts and computer reports; prepares new accounts.
- Review and approve all purchase requisitions and invoices for payment.
- Supervise collection of all funds due to the Municipality; supervise tax clerk to ensure accuracy of funds collected.
- Attend meetings with council, finance committee; other boards, commissions and professional seminars and conferences.
- ♦ Interact with outside auditors.
- Plan and manage a comprehensive investment program of all Municipality funds, provides daily cash flow analysis; comply financial and demographic information of the Municipality's bonds; prepares official prospectus for Municipality bond issues.

OPPORTUNITIES, CHALLENGES & TOP PRIORITIES

Deferred Maintenance Schedule

The Municipality is in need of a **5-year Capital Im- provements Program** which includes all *fixed* and *mobile assets*. The ability to forecast future expenditures and liabilities is a very high priority.

Financial Management System / Plan

The Municipality is in need of updating its financial controls and policies. The municipality does currently not have a formally-established Financial Management System / Plan.

A **5-year Strategic Financial Plan** is needed to inform current and guide future decision-making.

Organizational Development / Software

The Municipality currently uses OpenGov and is currently in the process of updating its HR Information System. Updating the municipality's financial software is critical. Evaluating financial systems, tools, processes policies and procedures needs to be done concurrently.

Professional Development

The Finance Department Staff are dedicated and skilled with a mix of public and private-sector experience. Evaluating staff skills and create a professional development strategy for the department will help to (a) create continuity of financial operations, (b) retaining of quality employees, (c) create greater efficiencies, (d) provide appropriate cross-training, and (e) minimize risk, waste, fraud and abuse.
